**Missionary Prayer Spotlight: Bob and Teresa Reister  
Serving in Japan with Christar**

When Jesus sent his disciples into surrounding villages to preach the gospel, he instructed them to seek out a place to stay, and if it was worthy to "let their peace come upon it". (Matthew 10:13) One of the objectives in the ministry model they are using is to find that "person of peace" through whom they can reach the wider community. The description of this kind of person is one who hungers and thirsts for righteousness, is willing to have a relationship with Bob and Teresa so they can hear the Word, and also that they would be eager to share what they have learned with others. While they have met a few people in Japan who seem hungry for God's Word, they have yet to meet anyone who is "eager" to learn and share God's Word. Bob and Teresa believe that God has people he has prepared for this role. Please pray with Bob and Teresa that those chosen people will be revealed to them.

When people cancel a scheduled study, or don't come to an outreach, it's easy to become discouraged, but they are reminded again and again that it is God who draws people to himself, and it is he who makes the blind to see and gives life eternal. They strive to be faithful in what God has placed before them, and they pray for his Kingdom to come into the hearts of those around them.
